

REQUIREMENTS FOR INDUCTION INTO HALL OF FAME

Nomination letter listing all significant and verifiable accomplishments and contributions. The more detail the better, especially from the zone level and up. All the nominees must be submitted to the chairman by the close of the state shoot.

BIOGRAPHICAL INFORMATION The NYS trapshooting Hall of Fame has two categories of inductees: competitor and contributor. A competitor who is still active in the sport must have at least 15 years registration, with a significant record. Competitors who have retired must have an outstanding record over a period of years. Deceased competitors are also eligible for induction. Considered for the contributor category are those who have served the NYSATA on a state level for a number of years and who have made outstanding contributions to the entire association.
